



HOW TO PREPARE FOR YOUR AUDITION

This production is a play; therefore, you do not need to prepare a song for the audition this year. However, you will still need to be familiar with the Kid Frankenstein storyline/plot and characters as well as the script excerpts. These can be found on the Snapshot Youth Theatre Company website.

Please prepare for your audition by spending some time at home to read through the audition scripts. You can also practice with your family and friends.

What should I bring to my audition?

Script excerpts if you have printed them out, water bottle, comfortable clothes to change into out of your school uniform.

Do I need to memorise the audition scripts?

No. You will not be judged on this. But memorising the scripts may help you get into character.

Tips to prepare a good audition.

1. Warm up your voice and body before the audition
2. Perform with characterisation
3. Practice lots so you know the script/characters well
4. Look at the audience when you are performing
5. Use gestures that suit the character you are playing: with your body, hands, arms, head and eyes
6. Act confident even if you are nervous

What does the audition panel look for when assigning roles to students?

1. Ability to perform a character to an audience on your own
2. Ability to interact with other actors during your audition
3. Ability to take direction and notes during the audition
4. Behaviour at auditions and in past shows: follows directions, respectful of others auditioning, etc.
