

HOW TO PREPARE FOR YOUR AUDITION

SINGING AUDITION:

Please learn the songs, "A WHOLE NEW WORLD," bars 1-38, and "PRINCE ALI," bars 1-43.

Please prepare all roles, male and female in these songs.

Use the Guided vocal tracks to start off with before practicing with the Performance accompanying tracks. Please note that you will sing to the Performance accompanying tracks (non-guided) in your audition, so make sure that you practice your songs well.

What should I bring to my audition?

Your music scores/lyrics if you need these.

Do I need to memorise my singing audition materials?

No. You will not be judged on this. But memorising songs will help you get into character.

Tips to prepare a good audition

1. Warm up your voice before the audition
2. Sing with expression
3. Practice lots so you know the songs well
4. Look at the audience when you sing
5. Use gestures during the songs with your body, hands, arms, head and eyes
6. Act confident even if you are nervous
7. Find videos and recordings of the show online to get a better idea of the story and the songs.

What does the audition panel look for when assigning roles to students?

1. Ability to sing and/or sell a song to an audience on your own
2. Ability to act
3. Ability to sing and act clearly and with volume
4. Behaviour at auditions: follows directions, respectful of others auditioning, etc.
